So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be awake and sober. For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, get drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.

For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to **receive** salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him. Therefore **encourage one another** and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

- 10. A mentor Acts 13:5, 15:37-39, Colossians 4:10, 2 Timothy 4:10 師傅(徒13:5,15:37-39;西4:10;提後4:10)
- 11. Influenced by Peter Galatians 2:13 受彼得影響(加2:13)
